

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION

The eligibility criteria for Admission into Under Graduate 5-year B. Arch. course shall be as mentioned below;

- i. The candidate should be of Indian Nationality.
- ii. The candidate should satisfy 'local'/'non-local' status requirements as laid down in the A.P. Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission) Order, 1974, as subsequently amended.
- iii. The candidate should have passed the qualifying examination either in,-
 - a. 10+2 or equivalent and secured 50% marks (45% in case of reserved categories) in aggregate with Mathematics as subject.

(OR)

- b. 10+3 Diploma (any stream) recognized by the State Government of Telangana and secured 50% aggregate marks (45% in case of reserved categories) with Mathematics as one of the subject which is mandatory.
- iv. The candidate should have qualified at National Aptitude Test in Architecture (NATA) /JEE (Main) Paper - II and should also have secured State Architecture Rank (SAR). All candidates who come with a passing valid score of NATA-2018/JEE (Main)-2018 Paper - II, at the time of "**Certificate Verification**" will alone be considered for seat allocation under the convener Quota of seats.

Note: *For candidates who appeared in both NATA and JEE (Main) Paper - II Examination, SAR shall be prepared on the basis of higher percentage of the two scores.*
